Are You Calling God a Liar?

God says His credibility is evident in the fulfillment of His Word, written through His ancient Bible prophets, and in creation itself. ([Isaiah 46:9-10](#); [II Peter 1: 19-21](#); [Romans 1: 20-32](#))

God says He cannot lie. ([Numbers 23:19](#); [Hebrews 6:18-19](#))

God says there is an eternity, and you must choose your eternal destiny in this life. ([John 3:16-18](#) and [36](#); [5:24](#))

God says your choice is either "eternal life" or the "second death," which is an eternal, tormenting awareness of separation from the glorious life that God provides. ([Luke 16:19-26](#); [Revelation 20:11-15](#))

God says that if your choice is eternal life, you may **know** that you have eternal life ([I John 5:13](#)), by believing God's testimony of His Son, Jesus Christ. ([I John 5:9-13](#))

God says if you don't **know** that you have eternal life, then you don't believe what God says, and you are calling God a liar. ([I John 5:9-13](#))

God says all have sinned and come short of the glory of God. ([Romans 3:23](#))

God says the wages of sin is death. ([Romans 6:23](#))

God says the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. ([Romans 6:23](#); [Romans 5:8-18](#))

God says this free gift is yours only if you accept it as a free gift, that it might be sure.

([Ephesians 2:8-9](#); [Romans 4:16](#) & [11:6](#))

God says you cannot earn a gift. You can earn wages, but again God says the wages of sin is death. ([Romans 6:23](#))

God says you have earned death, but He is willing to give you eternal life. ([II Peter 3:9](#); [Romans 5:8-18](#))

God says this eternal life is in His Son. ([I John 5:11](#))

God says once you accept the free gift of eternal life, God cannot take it away from you, or it wouldn't be eternal life, or free, and God would indeed be a liar. ([John 10:27-30](#); [Hebrews 6:17-20](#))

God says we are justified by the faith of Jesus Christ (in His own promise), and not by the works of the law.

([Galatians 2:16](#); [Romans 3:21-28](#))

God says the law was only given to show us that we are sinners in need of a Savior. ([Romans 3:19-31](#); [Galatians 3:24-25](#))

God's Justice Demands Payment for Sin, and His Love Provides the Payment

God says without the shedding of blood, there is no remission of sins. ([Hebrews 9:22](#))

God says the blood of Jesus Christ, His Son, was shed to buy us back, who were lost to sin. He was a willing substitute to pay the penalty for all our sins. ([Col. 2:6-14](#); [Rom. 5:6-8](#))

God says His love toward us is shown, "in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." ([Romans 5:8](#))

God says unless you repent of your sin nature and accept God's total payment for sin through Christ, you must pay the consequence for your own sin by your "second death."

([Romans 10:9-13](#); [John 3:16-18](#) and [36](#); [I John 1:9-10](#); [Rev. 20:11-15](#))

God says He has made the only provision, and will not be mocked by those who think they can earn or keep their salvation by "works." ([Matthew 7:21-23](#); [Galatians 3:1-3](#))

God says if Christ's death could reconcile us to God, then "...much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life..." ([Romans 5:8-11](#)). The resurrected Jesus Christ is "the way, the truth and the life." ([John 14:6](#))

Do You Believe What God Says?

...He that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.

And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may **know** that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.

([I John 5:10-13](#) – emphasis added)

You can **know** that you have eternal life simply by believing God, accepting Jesus Christ as your Savior and thanking God for His gift! The prayer that assures you of your salvation is not only, "Please, God, save me!" but also, "Thank you, Father. I accept your gift, and I know that I am saved." Please do it today. You may not have another opportunity:
